## Peripherally Enhanced Classroom

During the 2004-2005 school year we developed a new program designed to enhance the technology already in place in the classroom. Our goal was to begin providing peripherals to classroom teachers. We were able to add a digital camera and a flatbed scanner to 9 selected PEC classrooms.

With the success of the initial project, now named PEC I, we are adding another layer—PEC II. In PEC II, the selected PEC teacher will be able to choose from a list of selected peripherals and may enter as many times as they would like. In order to qualify for PEC II, you must be a previous PEC I selected teacher.

Items to choose from in PEC II:

- USB Thumb Drive
- Printer cartridges
- CD Burner
- USB Microscope

In order to participate in the program, PEC I and/or II, you must first be entered in to a drawing that will take place on the 25th of each month. To enter the drawing, you will need to submit a story to the district website, illustrating how you integrate technology into your instruction at the classroom level. All submitted stories will appear on the Staff, Student, and Parent web pages of the district website. A list of all teachers who participated during the month will be posted – along with the teacher who was randomly selected to be a part of the program.

These peripherals will remain district property, but will be assigned to you until such time as you are no longer employed by the district. Examples of what we are looking for:

- Differentiated learning experiences provided to students using classroom computers.
- Inclusion of educational software provided by the district
- Use of computers to help students understand where they are in meeting SAI objectives for the year.
- Uses of technology that impact your building's PDSA/SIP goal for the year.
