<p>4. <u>Word Connect</u> - Use graph paper to make at least 15 of your words connect.</p>	<p>5. <u>Alliteration</u> - Write five alliterative sentences with your spelling words.</p>	<p>6. <u>Picture</u> - Create a picture using your spelling words. You must include 15 of your spelling words and the picture must be colored.</p>
<p>7. <u>Stair Step Spelling</u> - Complete Stair Spelling with 15 of your most difficult spelling words.</p> <p>Example: C CA CAT</p>	<p>8. <u>Story</u> - Write a story using 15 of your spelling words. Underline the spelling words in your story.</p>	<p>9. <u>ZYX Order</u> - Put your spelling words in backwards ABC order.</p>
