

Transforming Uses of Technology

- Simulations, mathematical modeling, mind-mapping
- Collective learning and publishing using telecommunications and/or internet websites
- Assessment with electronic portfolios or online performance applications
- Student-initiated, self-directed learning tasks
- Co-operative groups solving real-world problems
- Use of groupware for collaborative writing, brainstorming, or other group activities

Examples:

-Students use a classroom email account to collaborate with a classroom in another community on a similar community issue

-Students conduct an online survey to investigate a school issue and publish their findings on the school website
