There was discussion that “fair is not equal...it means every kid gets what they need.” Teachers may continue to give a specific feedback award, on individual basis, and given at the discretion of teacher. This system is to help reinforce positive behaviors throughout our school.

When data shows us an area to target, we can use I-Care awards to help teach and reinforce positive behaviors.

SEB believes and research proves if we increase specific positive acknowledgements, specific positive behaviors will increase.
