

# Lunch Time in the Village Inn

The lunchroom is designed to promote a positive school climate that is beneficial to all. Listed below are the lunch / activity times for each grade level:

6<sup>th</sup> Grade 11:00 – 11:25      Activity 11:25 – 11:45  
4<sup>th</sup> Grade 11:30 – 11:55      Activity 11:55 – 12:15  
5<sup>th</sup> Grade 12:00 – 12:25      Activity 12:25 – 12:45

Students have a 45 minute lunch / activity period. Approximately 25 minutes is allocated for eating and 20 minutes for structured outside activities.

Student breakfast prices are \$1.35 and lunch prices are \$1.85 per lunch. Milk will be 45¢. Adult lunches will be \$2.25. Students may pay by the day, week or month. Children are responsible for holding on to their money until lunchtime. It is important that children have their money for lunch.

Reminder... No glass bottles may be brought into the lunchroom for safety reasons. Due to our wellness policy, no soda is allowed at lunch.

Free or reduced lunches are available upon approval. Forms are available in the Washington's Office.

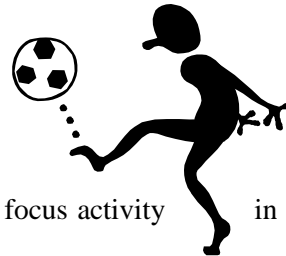
A note must be provided for students who will be leaving the school grounds for lunch. Parents are required to check student out at the office.
