We are using the guidelines of our **R.E.S.P.E.C.T.** code to establish and maintain our school goal of providing a safe and inviting learning environment. Please ask your child to review the **R.E.S.P.E.C.T.** code with you and explain how it applies to the classroom, lunchroom (Village Inn), hall, on the bus, at recess, and in the restroom.

R.E.S.P.E.C.T. means showing regard for the worth of someone or something. It takes three major forms: respect for oneself, respect for other people, and respect for all forms of life and the environment.

R	Responsibility – Being accountable for work, actions, and words
E	Etiquette – Doing the right thing at the right time
S	Safety – Choosing actions that do not harm self or others
P	Pride – Feeling good because you know you’ve done your best
E	Encouragement – Acknowledging someone positively for their actions
C	Character – Who you are when no one is watching
T	Teamwork – Working together for a common goal
