Public Concerns and Suggestions

The School Board is interested in receiving valid suggestions and concerns from members of the community. Any individual may make a suggestion or express a concern at any District or School Office. Public concerns or suggestions shall be referred to the appropriate level staff member or District administrator. Each concern or suggestion shall be considered on its merit.

An individual, not satisfied after following the channels of authority, may file a grievance under Board Policy 2:260, *Uniform Grievance Procedure*. Neither this policy nor the *Uniform Grievance Procedure* creates an independent right to a hearing before the Board.
