

TO THE PARENTS OF STUDENTS TAKING MEDICATION **AT SCHOOL**

In order to safely give medications at school, we must institute the following State of Illinois guidelines regarding **ALL** medications at school. These guidelines are in place to keep all students safe. Please be sure to read and follow these regulations or we will be unable to give your child medication at school.

Regulations require that medications, both prescription and over the counter (medication you can buy without a prescription), may **ONLY** be given with a doctor's signed order.

ALL MEDICATION MUST BE IN THE ORIGINAL CONTAINER.

Prescription medications must have a CURRENT pharmacy label.

ALL PRESCRIPTION MEDICATIONS MUST BE DELIVERED TO THE SCHOOL BY A RESPONSIBLE ADULT (children are not permitted to transport medications in their book bags or on the school bus).
