From the Principal

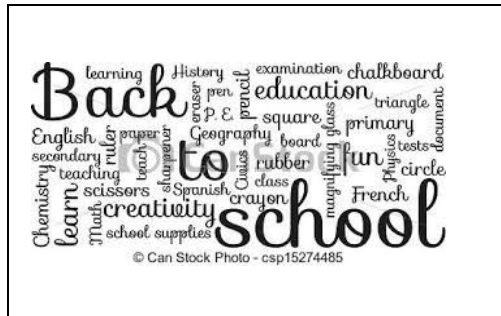
